The arena, Town basement and the Library are closed to the public. All programs have been cancelled until further notice.



#### **Waste Collection**

Currently, waste collection will be business as usual. Pick up will be every Friday. Please ensure that your tote is on the street in front of your home by 7:00 am and that all garbage is sealed in a bag.





In an effort to support residents and businesses during the COVID-19 pandemic, Council passed Bylaw #2020-16 -2020 Tax Penalty Bylaw Amendment for COVID-19 and Bylaw #2020-17 Cancellation of Residential Utility Penalties for COVID-19 at a Special Meeting of Council on April 7, 2020.

Bylaw #2020-17 allows for the cancellation of penalties and suspension of shut offs for non-payment of Utility bills for the period March 1—June 30, 2020 inclusively. We encourage residents who are financially able to, to keep their account current. Administration will continue to mail utility bills each month.

Bylaw #2020-16 extends the deadline to pay taxes without penalty due the COVID-19 pandemic.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Bylaw 1999-04, for the 2020 Tax Year only:

Any current taxes or portion thereof that remain unpaid on or before August 31, 2020, shall have late payment penalties imposed on the following dates:

On September 1, 2020 at 9% on unpaid current taxes; and On October 1, 2020 at 6% on unpaid current taxes.

### **Physical Distancing Protocol**

All Albertans are asked to practice physical distancing to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Physical distancing involves taking steps to limit the number of people you come into close contact with. It can help you reduce your risk of getting sick, and help prevent spreading the virus to others.

This is not the same as self-isolation. You do not need to remain indoors, but you do need to avoid being in close contact with people.

To protect yourself and others:

- Keep at least 6 feet (the length of a bicycle) from others when going out for groceries, medical trips and other essential needs
- Limit the number of times you leave your home for errands
- ♦ Try to shop at less busy times
- Order online to have groceries or other items delivered if possible
- Go for a walk in your neighborhood or park while maintaining distance from others
- Avoid overcrowding in elevators or other enclosed spaces
- Follow Alberta's recommendations on mass gatherings
- Wash or sanitize your hands after touching communal surfaces
