# **Community Pride and Town Beautification**

During the summer months many of us spend more time outside and enjoy the efforts that residents spend on yard

maintenance and beautification. These efforts are appreciated by your neighbours and are also noticed by the many visitors to our Town. Remember, a well-maintained yard shows pride of ownership!

In an effort to ensure that all residents maintain their yard and neighbourhood, the Town has several bylaws in place, and would like to remind residents of the following:

- Organic and Waste collection containers must be removed from the curbside by 9 pm on the day of collection.
- When parking an RV or utility trailer on the street, it must be attached to a tow vehicle at all times. The maximum time any vehicle (with or without a trailer) may be parked on the street is 72 hours.
- Property owners are responsible for keeping grass and weeds mowed in their yards and on the boulevard adjacent to their yards. The Town of Bon Accord Community Standards Bylaw requires that grass and weeds not exceed 10 cm (4 inches) in height.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and it is the responsibility of the pet owner to pick up your pet's waste. Remember, dog waste pollutes watersheds, poses health risks to humans, spreads diseases and parasites to other dogs, and presents several other problems for municipalities.

# Knit or Knots in the Park


While we can't meet in the library,
