Town Office Open by Appointment

Only To properly socially distance residents in our small entry area, please call to make an appointment if you wish to enter the Town office. One person per appointment. Taxes As per the Tax Penalty Bylaw Amendment for COVID-19; Bylaw 2020-16, property taxes were due August 31, 2020. Penalties were applied at a rate of 9% for unpaid taxes as of September 1, 2020. Additional penalties will be applied at a rate of 6% on October 1, 2020.
