a) Dark Sky Ad Hoc Committee Members – Six (6) individuals filled out application forms to be a part of the committee including 5 adults and one minor. The board reviewed all six applicants.

b) CSAB Membership – we are still in need of two youth members, and one more member at large. We also need to vote in a committee chair. Christina will contact the counsellor at Lilian Schick School to see if she has youth interested in being a part of the committee.

c) Community Collaboration Night – This meeting took place on February 7, 2024, at the Bon Accord Community Hall. Approximately 20 members from local community groups attended. It was a great opportunity to share struggles/challenges and come up with solutions. Christina has some follow-up to work on, the next meeting is in May.

d) Upcoming Events – Bon Accord Connects Spring Edition – At the collaboration night, it was suggested that perhaps we have a spring BA Connects event to not lose any momentum of making connections within our community. It is also a great opportunity for our local groups to recruit new members and volunteers. We were approved for a grant with FireSmart Canada to put towards a wildfire preparedness event, so it will be a larger event now. The grant money will still be put towards the original idea (hot dogs, door prizes), and the event will feature emergency and wildfire preparedness, as well as community connections.





e) Find Your Village – During a meeting with Sturgeon Public Schools, Helen Lawrence from SHINE program shared information about an event that happened regularly before the pandemic. It was held once a month, in the same location, during an evening, and everyone from Sturgeon County was welcome. Families, Seniors, Singles – all welcome. Dinner was served, there was often an educational component, like parenting or budgeting. Childcare was provided. The purpose of the event is to "find your village", find friends, connections etc. Helen still has this money in her budget and needs somewhere to host. I volunteered Bon Accord to be the host for this event. I shared that our arena mezzanine space would be perfect. We do not have to pay for anything, just provide the space and staff to help (Nicole and I). I think that this is a great opportunity for Bon Accord. This event will be in our residents back yard, making very few barriers to attend. It is a free meal for residents that need it. Shannon asked that we not book this event on a Wednesday or Thursday due to Golden Gem and Library events.

f) International Women's Day 2025 – Nicole and I attended a Women's Day event in Morinville. It was a nice event and after speaking with the FCSS team in Morinville, we have agreed to partner with them next year for the event. It will more than likely be a the MCCC, and we can bring a bus of attendees to enjoy the event. I have added this to our tentative budget for 2025.

g) Pickle Ball Update – Guidelines have been created for this program and Christina will be contacting the interested parties soon.

Round Table:

Shredding Event – Shannon asked if this event will be taking place again, especially for the local seniors. We do not have this event planned for 2024. Carole suggested that seniors use AMA for their services. Christina will investigate Morinville Seniors shredding resources.

COMMUNITY SERVICES REPORT April 1 – June 30, 2024



Programs

- PD Day Camps We did not run a camp in April. For May and June, we
 partnered with the Bon Accord Public Library for fun afternoon activities. We will
 be reevaluating these camps for Fall.
- Art Night Out in April we had 5 participants, and in May we had 6. This group is looking forward to coming back in September.
- Adult Field trips continue to be successful. In April a group of 13 travelled to The Old Strathcona Antique Market. The next trip will be in October.
- Free Tax Clinics April 9, 10 we offered a Free Tax Clinic to residents. We had a great volunteer that worked with 5 people here in town.
- Canada Revenue SCAM Smart Session & Coffee with Community Services on June 6 at the Jewel Box. We had 30 seniors attend the session.

Events

- Dark Sky Week We hosted an event at the library on April 4th. While we only had 6 attendees, it was a fun evening. We painted tote bags, had great snacks and watched a documentary.
- Find Your Village We hosted this event on April 28th and May 26th, in partnership with Redwater HYPE and SHINE Beyond Limits. We had a great turn out to both nights. Attendees enjoyed a free dinner and board games.
- Volunteer Appreciation Night On April 17th we hosted approximately 60 volunteers at this annual event. We celebrated with a Nacho Bar, juice and music. Each volunteer got to take home a bedding plant and we gave away 10 door prizes.
- Food Bank Drive We changed the format of the event this year. We had the Legal Lions Bus sit at the Town Office parking lot and residents brought us their donations so we could stuff the bus. It was a great day, and we collected 2067 pounds of food, and \$290 in cash donations. Everyone that donated was asked to put their name in for a door prize. We had a selection of 14 prizes, which we thought would be an incentive to donate. In the end, most residents didn't seem to care about the prizes. Next year we could probably just have one prize or forego all together.
- Bon Acord Connects Spring Edition This was a first-time event for us. We had 33 tables confirmed – a few artisan vendors, local groups and businesses. It was a slower event than we had experienced in the Fall, with approximately 100 attendees that day. It was a very smokey day from wildfires, which may have contributed to the lower attendance.

- Bike Rodeo This event was on May 22, and due to rainy weather, was held inside the Bon Accord arena. We had 26 kids participate and learn from local RCMP, Community Peace Officers and AHS.
- Seniors BBQ Due to extreme wind, this event was held at the Bon Accord Arena. Was a great event, with approximately 100 attendees.
