Our goal is to create an environment together where men can meet on a regular basis for their mental health and wellbeing. Dwayne has volunteered to lead this for us. Christina and Dwayne will meet to plan the first session.
- D) Seniors BBQ Event Christina asked for feedback on entertainment for this event. Everyone agreed that a live band wasn't needed, and that a DJ would work fine.
