- Given to the Provinces by the Constitution A&1867 and 1982)
- Given to Municipalities through the Municipal Government Act













- Alberta Land Stewardship Act
- Land Use Framework
 - "a blueprint for landuse management and decisio-making to address growth pressures"
 - Establishes Regional Plans based on 7 major watersheds/municipal boundaries
 - Bon Accord is within the North Saskatchewan Regional Plan Area ('underway')

TOWN OF BON ACCORD





- Municipal Government Act
 - Guides how municipalities operate and make decisions
 - One of the most farreaching statutes in Alberta (affects private citizens, developers, businesses, and every ministry in the Province)
 - Has been amended to reflect government priorities (e.g. December 2017, 2018, most recently 2020/21 through Bill 48 the Red Tape Reduction Act)

WHAT IS AN MDP?

- Required for municipalities in Alberta
- Reflect longrange goals and aspirations of the community.
- Must be consistent with IDP
- Municipal Government Act (MGA) states that an MmBst address:
 - Future land use
 - The manner and proposals for future development
 - Land use coordination with adjacent municipalities
 - The provision of municipal services and facilities
 - The subdivision and development regulations
 - The provision of MR and MSR
 - The protection of agricultural operations







WHAT IS AN MDP?

- MGA states that an MDImay address:
 - Financing/programming of municipal infrastructure
 - Programs relating to physical, social, & economic development
 - Environmental matters
 - Financial resources
 - Economic development
 - Any other matters Council wishes to address
- may contain statements regarding development constraints
- may contain policies respecting the provision of conservation reserve







RELATIONSHIP TO THE LUB

- MDP sets out the long term vision for the Town
- LUB is dayto-day regulatory document that controls use and development of land
- Some MDP policies will be implemented through the LUB
- Blueprint (MDP) vs Rulebook (LUB)






RELATIONSHIP TO THE LUB

MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN	LAND USBYLAW
Future oriented planning goals and policies	Regulatescurrent land use activities
More strategic, often less prescriptive (but not always!)	More prescriptivænd specific
Provides ageneralized future land use pattern for the municipality	Divides the municipality intend use districts provides lists of permitted and discretionary land uses that may be developed within each district
Describes the infrastructure, services, and assets that will be required Regulates the specific details of development including height, to achieve a vision for the future density, setbacks, screening, signage, etc.)	
All ASPs, ARPs, and bylaws must be consistent the MDP	Primary tool for assessing development and subdivision applications must be consistent with the MDP









UPDATE PRIORITIES

- Current MDP was adopted in 2016
 - Town was a member of the Capital Region Board in 2016
 - Included information required to access funding from thefederal New Deal for Cities and Communities grant program
 - Does Council want this MDP to also be the Town's sustainability plan?

- Reflect recent amendments to the MGA and other provincial acts and regulations
- Incorporate the Town's existing Gateway
 Plan into the MDP
- Incorporate the Future Road Network shown in the Town's Master Servicing Plan
- Update spatial mapping information to include known development constraints and annexed lands
- Planning best practices



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
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
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EXISTING FUTURE LAND USE MAPS

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


