The R.C.M.P. are responsible for law enforcement in rural Alberta.

They patrol large areas with an everincreasing population as more people move to rural communities.

The Morinville R.C.M.P. Detachment has about 20 officers to look after Sturgeon County region assisted by Sturgeon County Peace Officers. They cover an area of 2,109 square kilometers with a population of over 34,000 which includes acreages, farms, hamlets, rural subdivisions, and towns: Bon Accord, Gibbons, Legal, Morinville, and Redwater.
